

Were you aware of the ability of "block selection" in the isCOBOL Editor under Eclipse?

Veryant's IDE gives you the ability to select a block in your source code to simplify editing in vertical mode.

This helps when you need to delete a block of source (for example all the "value" clauses in the image below) or to write the same code in more lines.

To activate this feature, you need to click on tool-bar button "Toggle Block Selection Mode" or press "Alt+Shift+A". The cursor will change to a large Plus sign. To select the text you need, Click at the top left and drag to the bottom right of the block you want. Use "Ctrl+C" or right click and choose the option to copy your selection to your clipboard. Click on the Toggle button, or press "Alt+Shift+A" again to return to the normal cursor.
